There is a small per person charge that is well worth the day long access it provides.

[Niagara-On-The-Lake](#) was awarded the title of Canada's prettiest town. It exudes history, culture and elegance. There are many boutiques offering interesting goods in this quaint village. Historic [Fort George](#) is located just on its outskirts.
